About the Show

The unearthed serenity in a mother's sarong. The smell of burnt photos. And what if forgetting is not erasure, but mere misplacement?

An experimental and multisensorial theatre experience, Alu & Lesung tracks the journey of an ensemble as they revisit the calmer moments in their lives, the events that happen after where they deal with the loss of security, followed by a newfound journey of healing.

This project zooms in on individuals who are private about their own challenges and struggles. Vulnerable moments are often kept to themselves and away from others, even from the people close to them. Audiences take on a voyeuristic lens by peeking into these private moments. This production utilizes movement, minimal text in various languages, scent, light, sound, and projections. Alu & Lesung is the fifth production of Theatresauce's 2023 season.

Aila (Ensemble) is a content writer by day and an actor by night. After taking a brief hiatus from theater to pursue a Bachelor's degree in Archaeology (which she has not put to good use, by the way), Aila is now using the time to rediscover his artistic voice as an adult(ing) performer. Aila's recent performances include "nafas" and "Orang Muda, Darah Muda" in the 2022 season of the Emerging Directors Lab (EDL) program, "Asal" (2022), and "both of them were me" (2022). Whenever she needs a breather, Aila escapes to the forest to seek solace and reconnect with his inner being and the greater living beyond her. Lim Sheng Hui (Ensemble) (she/her) is a theatre practitioner who believes in the power of theatre to tap into the subconscious and express the inexpressible. She graduated with a BA in Drama from Vassar College, New York, in 2017 and completed the Emerging Director's Lab with Theatresauce in 2019. She has performed, written, or directed for Theatresauce (DUST; Mockingbird; Saturn Return), Hastur Films (Wounds), and KongsiKL (Arboreal). Sheng works as a freelance writer and an independent cat rescuer (ig: @_gentlehouse) when she is not in the theatre.

Tharanii Karthigesu (Ensemble), a passionate performer, has been taken by the arts since young. She practiced drama and performing arts at The New School where she found a deeper understanding of the arts and a newfound interest in theatrical production. After a two-year break, Tharanii stepped into the performing scene once again working on a short film for a campaign by Cuba Dengar Dulu called "Love on the Menu" (2022) as well as some production work for Mr. World Malaysia (2022) and "Wondering Women" (2023) by Actors Emergence. And now, she's diving into uncharted waters—devised theatre! With wide-eyed excitement, Tharanii is thrilled to collaborate and be a part of Alu & Lesung.

Iwaz(Sound Designer) is a sound and visual designer based in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. He blurs the lines between the realms of sound and imagery, exploring synergistic relationship between electronic music, traditional music, generative arts, and music synthesis.With a keen eye for aesthetics and a passion for pushing the boundaries of creativity, iwaz has carved a unique niche in the world of art and technology through multidisciplinary collaborations. As one of the co-founders of Seni.Tibatiba and Supercodex, he leads a community driven collective of passionate creatives focusing on technology in music and visual arts.

Syamsul Azhar (Lighting + Multimedia Designer) works across theatre, film, and contemporary art as a multimedia and lighting designer, often employing technology as a performative element in his work. He has designed across diverse places and spaces, and collaborated on many projects with Five Arts Centre. Syamsul is a member of Five Arts Centre as well as sans, a loose interdisciplinary collective of artists creating works for performance and exhibition. Violacea Low (Production Manager + Assistant Stage Manager), or more fondly known as Vio, hails from the city of flash floods: & water cuts: Kuala Lumpur. Her previous theatre stints include acting and stage managing in local productions such as Life Sdn Bhd: Mental Health (2022), Both of Them Were Me (2022), Her Story (2023), Melur The Musical (2023) and Saturn Return (2023). When she is not teaching primary school kids or worrying over her Master's thesis, she hosts Astro SYOK's TheVioIsUs podcast with her sister! It's a pandemic coping mechanism turned passion project. Lastly, she loves saying hi to the super manja stray cats in her neighbourhood.

Shevone Seow (Stage Manager) is a freelance music practitioner based in Malaysia. She focuses on instrumental music composition/ production and audio editing. She has acted in a short musical, Goeng Si OTW from the Don't Let Hantu Know (2022) and stage managed for Theatresauce's Coyotes and 2022 season EDL shows. As for her musical works, she wrote and arranged several tracks for the game Research Story from PetalCatGames.Currently, she's working in the event and coaching industry whilst working on overall personal growth (to support that entrepreneurial dream!). Fun fact, she may be a musician but she tends to be more on the logical than the creative end. Planners and systems are her best friends.

Abdul Sami Shahid (Season Archiver) is a film student in Sunway University. His most recent projects include directing and authoring the script for his short film The Lunchbox. He is continually creating film-related content and has previously worked on various passion projects in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia and Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. He directed CRUNCH, a short film that received the People's Choice Award at the 2021 UCSI Student Film Festival. He worked as a freelance filmmaker in Riyadh for prominent brands and entertainment places, generating commercial campaigns, event coverage, and photography, prior to furthering his education in Malaysia.

Jazzie Lee Jin Jye (Season Designer) is a digital media designer, theatre-maker, and filmmaker. She is the co-founder of lowercase laboratories, where she made her directorial debut in the full-length production both of them were me (2022). Jazzie is the poster designer for Theatresauce in Season 2022 and 2023. She was projection designer for Theatresauce's Come Home and Eat (2023) and Don't Like It Here? Then Leave (2022). In film, Jazzie has directed, produced, edited, and set designed. Jazzie is also a member of the autism spectrum, where she finds making art her avenue to understand and process the world around her.
